

#### **NUGENT APPEAL**

Nugent Care, educate, protect and inspire children young people, adults and families who are vulnerable and at risk through our schools, care homes, community and social work services. Nugent is over 140 years old and advocates for people and strives to be the voice for the voiceless.

We are reaching out to you who may be able to support us in donated items for our new service 'The Orchards' – The Orchards is a supported living service in Billinge, Wigan for adults with learning disabilities, physical disabilities or who are suffering with mental health issues.

The scheme will be a supported tenancy, where people will have access to a dedicated team to help support with housing benefits, understanding of tenancy agreements and how to maintain agreements. There will be an onsite communal hub in one of the houses which will be split into different spaces with a variety of facilities for our residents. The purpose of the hub is to provide a safe environment where our beneficiaries can build meaningful friendships, engage in activities and develop their skills.

Giving our beneficiaries the opportunity to engage in different activities will build their confidence, increase their independence and help them to live a fulfilled life.

We are looking for support in sourcing items for the hub. Please check the Nugent Care or parish website for further information and a look at their wish list. Are you able to donate any items? There are some big ticket items on their list but also items such as beanbags, cushions, gardening tools, kitchen items, stationery, face masks and towels.

# **Donations for Ukraine**

Your local collection point is:

St Margaret Clitherow Centre, Croxteth Drive, Liverpool, L<sub>17</sub> 1AA

We are collecting the following items to donate to Ukraine:

- First aid kits and battlefield first aid kits (including sterile dressings, safety pins, antiseptic fluid/cream/spray, disposable gloves, burn free kits, eye wash)
- Bandages different widths
   (including halo chest seals, torniquets, splints, QuikClot Combat Gauze, Steri-Strips, triangular bandages, Tourni-Key Plus)
- Toiletries
   (including toothbrushes, toothpaste, soap, shampoo)
- · Bedding, sleeping bags, blankets, mattresses
- Generators and different types of chargers
- Nappy rash creams and baby bath lotions (all ages and sizes)
- · Powdered baby milk and feeding bottles
- Pain relief (e.g Paracetamol, Ibuprofen)
- Warm underclothing (including socks)
- Sanitary products
- Nappies (all ages and sizes)
- Rucksacks

Please note, as the delivery chain is currently at capacity, we are exploring various options for delivery. In the unlikely event that we are unable to supply these items to Ukraine, all goods will go to a local charity.
